What is a Citizens' Academy?

The purpose of the Multi-Agency Law Enforcement Citizen's Academy is to develop positive relations between law enforcement and the community through education.

Academy participants learn how law enforcement agencies operate and gain an understanding of the challenges facing law enforcement in this rapidly growing community.

The Citizens' Academy provides opportunities for open discussions. Participants are encouraged to share comments and ideas regarding problems and solutions.

Participants in the Citizens' Academy meet for three hours one night a week for eight weeks plus two Saturdays. Upon completion, each participant will receive a certificate of completion.

How do I Apply to Attend the Citizens' Academy?

Complete and mail the attached application.

There is no fee.

You must be at least 18 years old and have no misdemeanor conviction in the past year. If you have a felony conviction, you will not be selected to attend the Citizens' Academy.

The sponsoring law enforcement agencies for the multi-agency Citizens' Academy seek to fill each academy session with a cross section of the community.

You will be notified if you are selected to participate in the next academy.
