

PFPD Special Needs Book



Parents and Caregivers, the Post Falls Police Department has a tool to assist in the identification and location of children and adults with mental and physical disabilities who wander away from their homes or care facilities.

We maintain a Special Needs Book in our Dispatch Center, which consists of information and pictures provided by caregivers of persons who may be unable to communicate with law enforcement personnel in an emergency situation. Should one of these individuals be reported missing or found wandering, the information in our book helps identify the individual and safely return home.

The book contains pertinent information and a current photo. Information is updated annually or whenever we are advised of changes by the parent or caregiver. The information is only used for the purpose of identifying and locating an individual who is reported missing or found wandering.
