### **City of Post Falls Updates:**

- The City of Post Falls Council adopted an ordinance providing the Mayor with Emergency Powers. I have attached the Ordinance and the Order for everyone's review. I have also attached the press release. This was a joint effort between the City of Post Falls and the City of CDA. Other agencies notified include the Governor's office, Panhandle Health District, PF School District, KC OEM, Kootenai Fire, and PF Chamber. The Press Release will go to normal media outlets.
- City Hall will be closed for drop in customers. A phone number will be placed on the door for deliveries and necessary access. Staff will continue to work, and Community Development will schedule appointments to continue servicing customers. Department Heads will meet Monday morning to discuss logistics.
