MUTE YOUR PHONES**

**THERE ARE NOW 61 CONFIRMED CASES IN KOOTENAI COUNTY UP TWO FROM FRIDAY. ALL ARE HOME ISOLATING. THE PHD COVID-19 HELP LINE IS ONLY BEING STAFFED MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY FROM 0800 – 1700. FRIDAY THEY HANDLED 70 CALLS.**

**PANHANDLE HEALTH IS NO LONGER MONITORING 39 KOOTENAI COUNTY RESIDENTS WHO HAD PREVIOUSLY TESTED POSITIVE.**

**KH CONTINUES TO HAVE NO INPATIENTS WAITING TEST RESULTS. THEY DID 55 TESTS YESTERDAY**

WE ALSO DISCUSSED THE EVER-CHANGING PROTOCOLS COMING FROM IOEM AND FEMA. WE**

**ASKED THAT WE BE ABLE TO GIVE INPUT TO THE AFTER ACTION REPORT WHEN ALL IS DONE AND GOVERNOR LITTLE SEEMED VERY RECEPTIVE TO THAT IDEA. REMEMBER THAT THE FULL PLAN CAN BE SEEN AT REBOUND.IDAHO.GOV.**

**WE CONTINUE TO SEE DEFIANCE TO THE QUARANTINE ORDER FROM PEOPLE WHO COME TO IDAHO TO RECREATE. BOAT RAMPS AND GOLF COURSES SEEM TO BE THE PRIMARY LOCATIONS OF OFFENSES. DEPUTIES SPENT TIME AGAIN THIS WEEKEND EDUCATING OUT OF STATE VISITORS AND PASSING OUT FLIERS.**
